FORMA

Affermativa

soggetto + was/were

Negativa

soggetto + was/were + not/n't

I was
you were
he was
she was
it was
we were
you were
they were

estesa	contratta
I was not	I wasn't
you were not	you weren't
he was not	he wasn't
she was not	she wasn't
it was not	it wasn't
we were not	we weren't
you were not	you weren't
they were not	they weren't

USO

Si usa il **past simple** per parlare di un'azione o di una situazione che è iniziata e **si è conclusa** nel **passato**, anche se solo da poco tempo.

Past simple: i verbi to have / have got

FORMA

Affermativa

soggetto + has/have + (got)

I had
you had
he had
she had
it had
we had
you had
they had

! Alla forma *had* non si aggiunge il rafforzativo *got*.
I had a dog when I was little.

Interrogativa e risposte brevi

Was/Were + soggetto + ... + ?

Yes, + soggetto + was/were

No, + soggetto + was/were + n't

	affermativa	negativa
Was I ... ?	Yes, you were .	No, you weren't .
Were you ... ?	I was .	I wasn't .
Was he ... ?	he was .	he wasn't .
Was she ... ?	she was .	she wasn't .
Was it ... ?	it was .	it wasn't .
Were we ... ?	you were .	you weren't .
Were you ... ?	we were .	we weren't .
Were they ... ?	they were .	they weren't .
