

Act out the scene - Secondaria

Activity: Bring the story to life with performance!

- **1. Objective:** Encourage interpretive reading, expression, and critical thinking through performance.
- 2. Select a key scene: Choose a dramatic or pivotal scene.
- **3. Form groups and assign roles:** Each group selects or is assigned a scene and distributes roles—actors, director, and optionally, a scriptwriter.
- **4. Rehearse & adapt the script:** Allow time for groups to read, edit, and modernize the language (if desired). Encourage them to add emotion, movement, or even change the setting.
- **5. Use props or music:** Let students add costumes, background music, or simple props to enhance the scene. This is optional but boosts engagement.
- **6. Perform:** Groups act out their scene in front of the class. Encourage expression and clarity.
- **7. Debrief and discuss:** After each performance, discuss:
 - **a.** What did this scene show about the characters?
 - **b.** What choices did the group make in adapting it?
 - **C.** What emotions did they want to express?
