

## Act out the scene - Primaria

## **Activity: Bring the story to life with performance!**

- **1. Objective:** Build confidence, encourage speaking, and improve comprehension through fun dramatization.
- **2.** Choose a simple scene: Select a short, clear scene from the Pearson English Readers.
- **3. Assign roles:** Let students pick characters (or animals!). Keep it playful and non-competitive.
- **4. Support with visuals:** Provide props or puppets and simplified scripts with key lines or repeated phrases. Practice pronunciation together.
- **5. Practice in groups:** Give each group 5–10 minutes to rehearse. Help them act with gestures and tone.
- **6. Perform for the class:** Each group acts out the scene. Applaud every effort—focus on fun and creativity, not accuracy.
- **7. Reflect together:** Ask: "How did it feel to be your character?" "What was the funniest part?"
